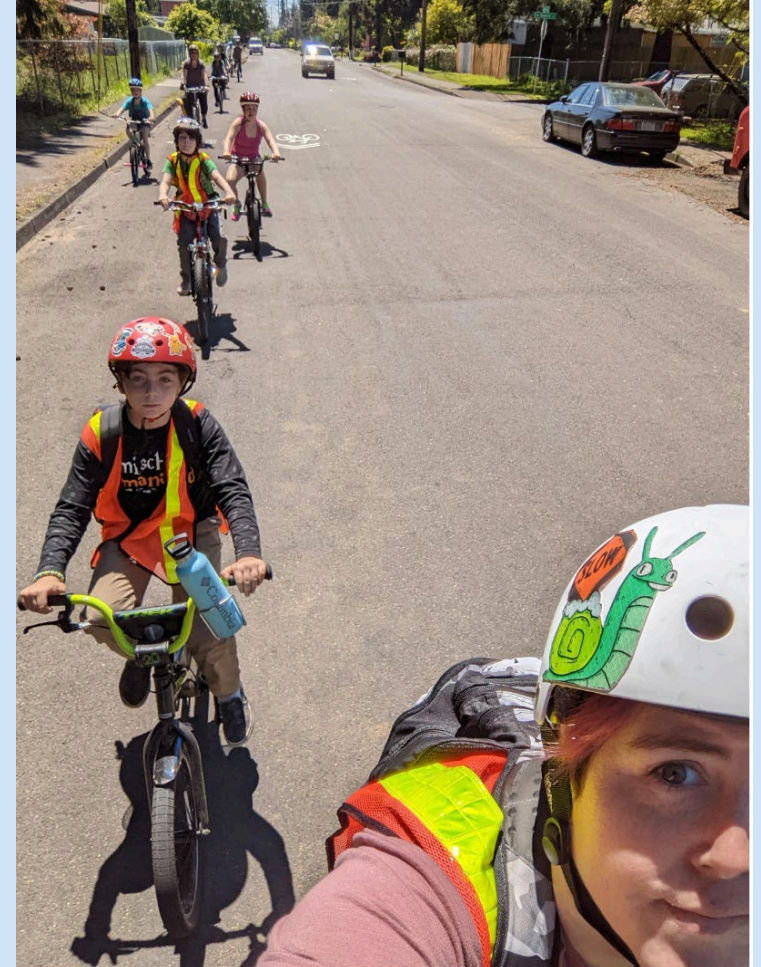

# Ped/Bike Education

- Any school can sign up, all schools in the district are eligible!
- Pedestrian and/or Bike Safety Lessons
  - SRTS Program staff are available to teach a one-time or short series of lessons (in-person or virtual) (2022-2023 SY)
  - Train school staff to teach curriculum
  - Often offered through SUN Program or during health or PE class





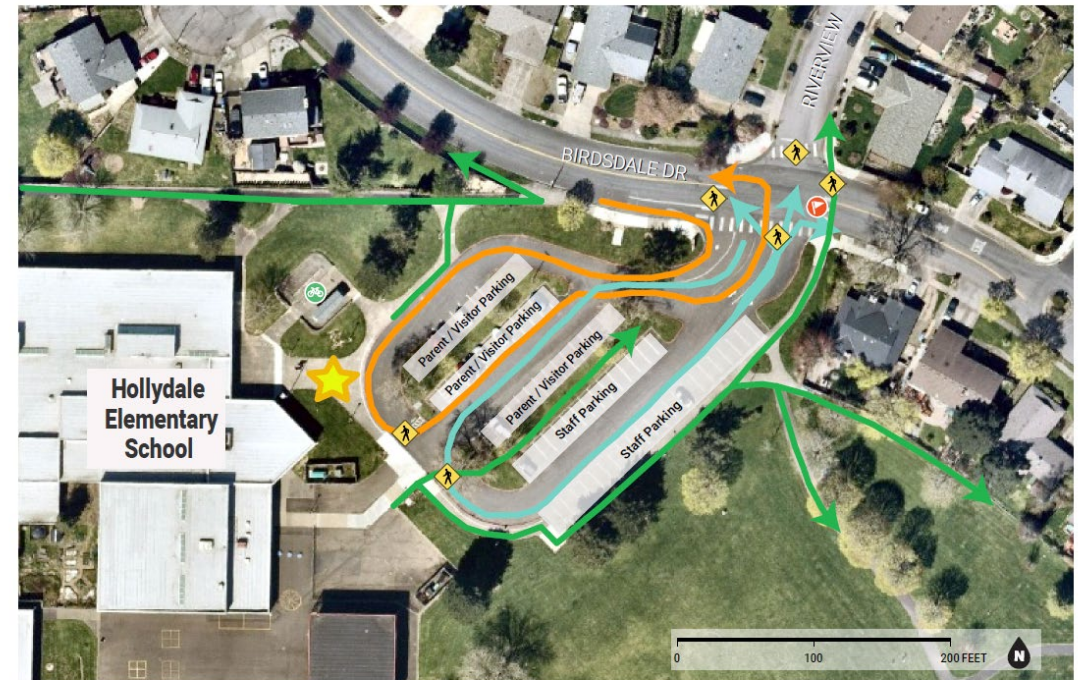
# Walk + Roll Events
