- Nicole we would like to get your help in developing research questions, designing activities, developing surveys and/or interviews, recruiting participants, helping to interpret data, disseminate findings and research sub committees or working groups. What part of this interests you?
- Barb Rainish thinks this is awesome, if it is real. I feel like we are never really listened to. She also wanted to flag a book "The Life of Henrietta Lacks". This family was used for research, and not even aware of it.
- Dave Daley said, we have lots of different communities, how do we determine what is the best way to evaluate all of them?
- Nicole we need to use different methods of evaluation with different groups. It is hard, and will take time.
- Irma stated we need to have multiple communities and try to cover everyone in our research.
- Scott Moore wants clarification on what we would be overviewing, he would like to know how this info is coming into ADVSD and how it is being presented to us. He would also like to get the information quickly presented to us. We need this to be useful. We also need to hold the county accountable for this.
- Alex Garcia Lugo talked about limits on what we can do, due to money and time. We want to serve all populations as best we can, be we have constraints.
- Anne Lindsay commented that she hears that our goal is to create and identify roles for those on the councils to help with this work. We are being invited to help. Let's take this opportunity.
