5	6.	I have past experience as an Inspector, Project Manager, and Manager planning,

8	7.	I managed the construction of the Sauvie Island Bridge and the Sellwood Bridge,

22	excessive runoff sedimentation, mud and debris that was caused by excavation of the hillside.		
23	15.	In my opinion the conditions I observed create a public road hazard and are an

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


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


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## Site Visit Report 645 SE Pounder Rd - March 1, 2021



Emily and I went out to Pounder Rd this morning to look at the damage and decide what we need from an Engineering Consultant to allow us to repair the failed roadway embankment and culvert.

## **Observations:**

The roadway embankment on the east side of Pounder Rd near 645 SE Pounder has failed and slid towards Pounder Creek, destabilizing the east half of the roadway. The pavement in this section of roadway is visibly depressed with alligator cracking present adjacent to the failed slope. The slope failure is a result of oversaturation of the roadbed that was caused by at least partial blockage of the County's culvert, which carries water runoff from the uphill slope on the west side of the roadway to Pounder Creek on the east side of the road.

The owner from the house across the street from 645 SE Pounder Rd (600 SE Pounder Rd) came out to speak with us and gave us some background and history of the situation from her perspective.

600 SE Pounder said that the previous owner of 645 SE Pounder worked with County Land Use to install drainage piping all over the slope to the south of the 645 house on the west side of the road. At least some of that drainage piping appears to have been removed (you can see the remnants of it laying all over the property). Water is sheeting off of the slope in multiple areas, flowing down to the road.

The west end of our culvert (inlet), which could help drain that water into Pounder creek, is not visible and is likely completely buried, either under mud and hay bales, or under large rocks and silt. The exact location of the culvert inlet is difficult to determine. The east end of the culvert (outlet) is visible from the roadway and appears to have a very small amount of water flowing out of it and into Pounder Creek.

Some of the water coming off the hill on the south side of 645's driveway is flowing down a newly cut ditch (presumably by the 645 homeowner) along the County ROW from 645 all the way to the shared drive way of 821/915/921 SE Pounder Rd. About 520 feet of new ditching has been cut along the County ROW.

In addition to the water coming from the slope south of 645's driveway, there is also significant ponding just north of the driveway. There is an existing ditch that runs along County ROW north of the driveway and there is likely a culvert beneath the driveway that is no longer functioning, leading to the ponding. This water has filled the existing ditch and is sheeting across the road, just north of the failure across the road.


