


Getting care







Disqualifications	Diabetes



Preventive Care Screening Reminders

Adult Colorectal Screening

Coverage for adults age 45 to 75 (New – Previously recommended at age 50)

Breast Cancer Screening (HRSA - Health Resources and Services Administration)

- Women ages 40 to 74 with average-risk for breast cancer
- Screening mammography at least every 2 years and as frequently as once a year

Breast Cancer Screening (USPSTF – U.S. Preventive Services Task Force)

- Women age 50 to 74
- Screening mammography every 2 years

Cervical Cancer Screening (USPSTF – U.S. Preventive Services Task Force)

- Women age 21 to 65
- Pap smear every 3 years for women 21 to 29.
- Pap smear every 3 years for women 30 to 65, or a high-risk HPV (hrHPV) test every 5 years, or a Pap smear in combination with a hrHPV test every 5 years.

Cervical Cancer Screening: Human Papillomavirus Testing (HRSA - Health Resources and Services Administration)

- Women age 30+
- HPV test with Pap test in women with prior normal Pap results, beginning at age 30 and occurring no more frequently than every 3 years.

Alternative Care – 2022 Changes

Benefit changes meet the new essential health benefits (EHB) requirements in Oregon.

- Naturopathic Care Included in plans at the primary office visit cost share with no visit limitation. Copays now apply to the annual out of pocket maximum.
- Self-referred Chiropractic care \$15 copay, 20 visit limit now an essential health benefit.
- Self-referred Acupuncture \$15 copay, 20 visit limit, now an essential health benefit.

*This number can be dialed inside and outside the United States. Before the phone number, dial "001" for landlines and "+1" for mobile lines if you're outside the United States. Long-distance charges may apply, and we can't accept collect calls. The phone line is closed on major holidays (New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July Fourth, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas). It closes early the day before a holiday at 10 p.m. Pacific time (PT), and it reopens the day after a holiday at 4 a.m. PT.



Dependent Out of Area Benefit

Your dependent children have access to care beyond urgent and emergency care outside the Kaiser Permanente network. Your out-of-area benefit covers routine, continuing, and follow-up care for dependent children residing outside the service area.

Services: With this benefit, you will pay 20% of the charges for the service received.* This benefit includes the following services:

- √ 10 office visits per year, including preventive care, primary care, specialty care, outpatient mental health and chemical dependency services, allergy injections, and outpatient physical therapy.
- ✓ 10 diagnostic X-rays and lab tests per year (covers diagnostic X-rays but excludes CT, MRI, PET, and other specialty scans).
- √ 10 prescription drug fills per year

*Payments for these services count toward your plan's out-of-pocket maximum.

^{*}The cost share is subject to deductible on HSA-qualified high deductible health plans.

Dependent Out of Area Benefit

Payment: You have 2 payment options for services you receive using the out-of-area benefit for dependent children:

- ✓ The health care provider can bill Kaiser Permanente directly, and no claim needs to be submitted.
- ✓ You can pay out of pocket and submit a Non-Plan Care Information claim form for reimbursement. This form can be found at kp.org/disclosures.

Eligibility: The following requirements apply:

- ✓ The dependent child must meet eligibility requirements and be under the age limit specified in the Evidence of Coverage.
- ✓ The dependent child must be living outside the service area. Dependent children who reside in another Kaiser Foundation Health Plan service area may use their visiting member benefit.
