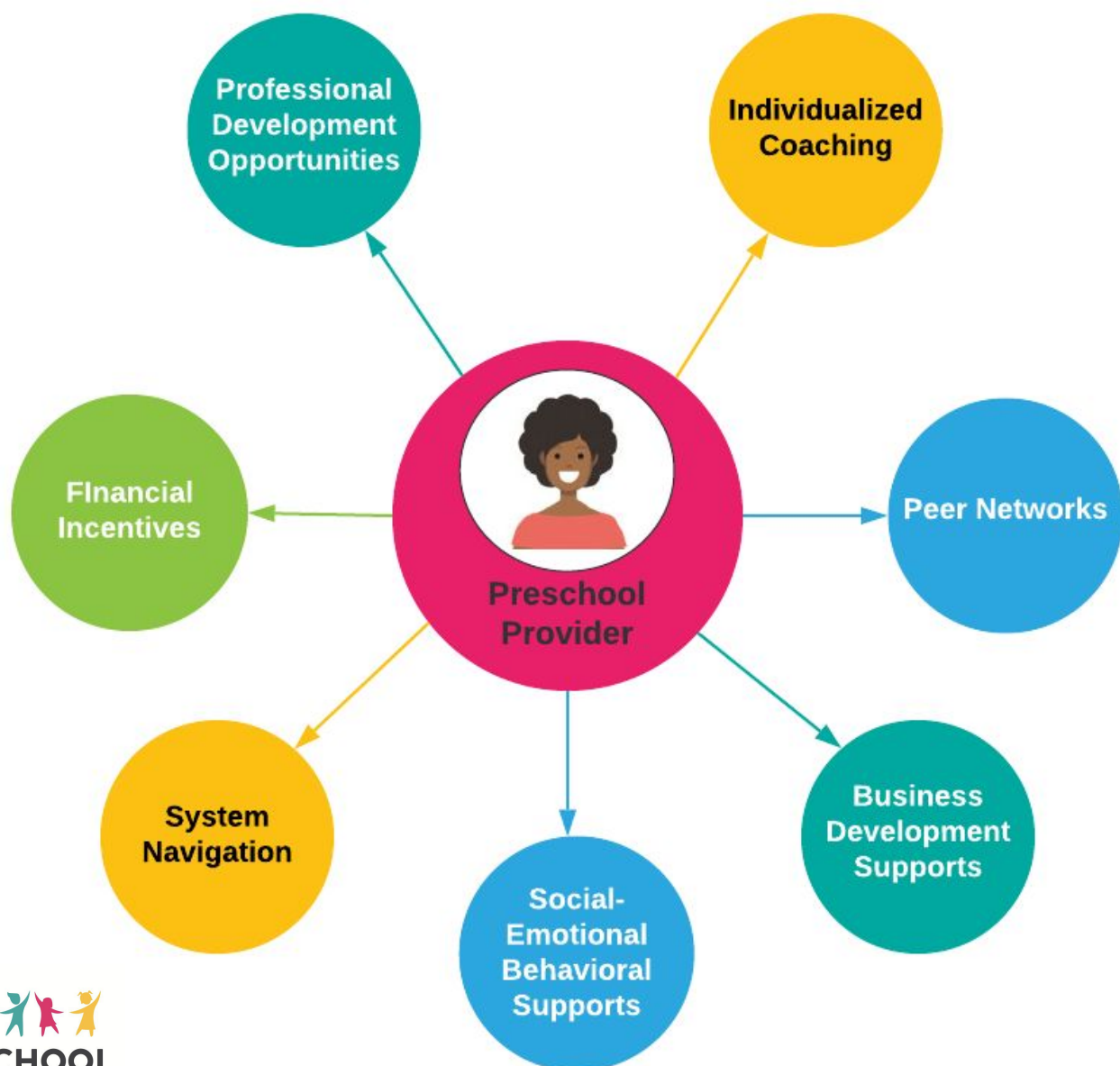


Preschool For All Pathways Program

[Preschool for All](#) will give 3 and 4 year olds in Multnomah County access to free, culturally responsive, inclusive preschool experiences.

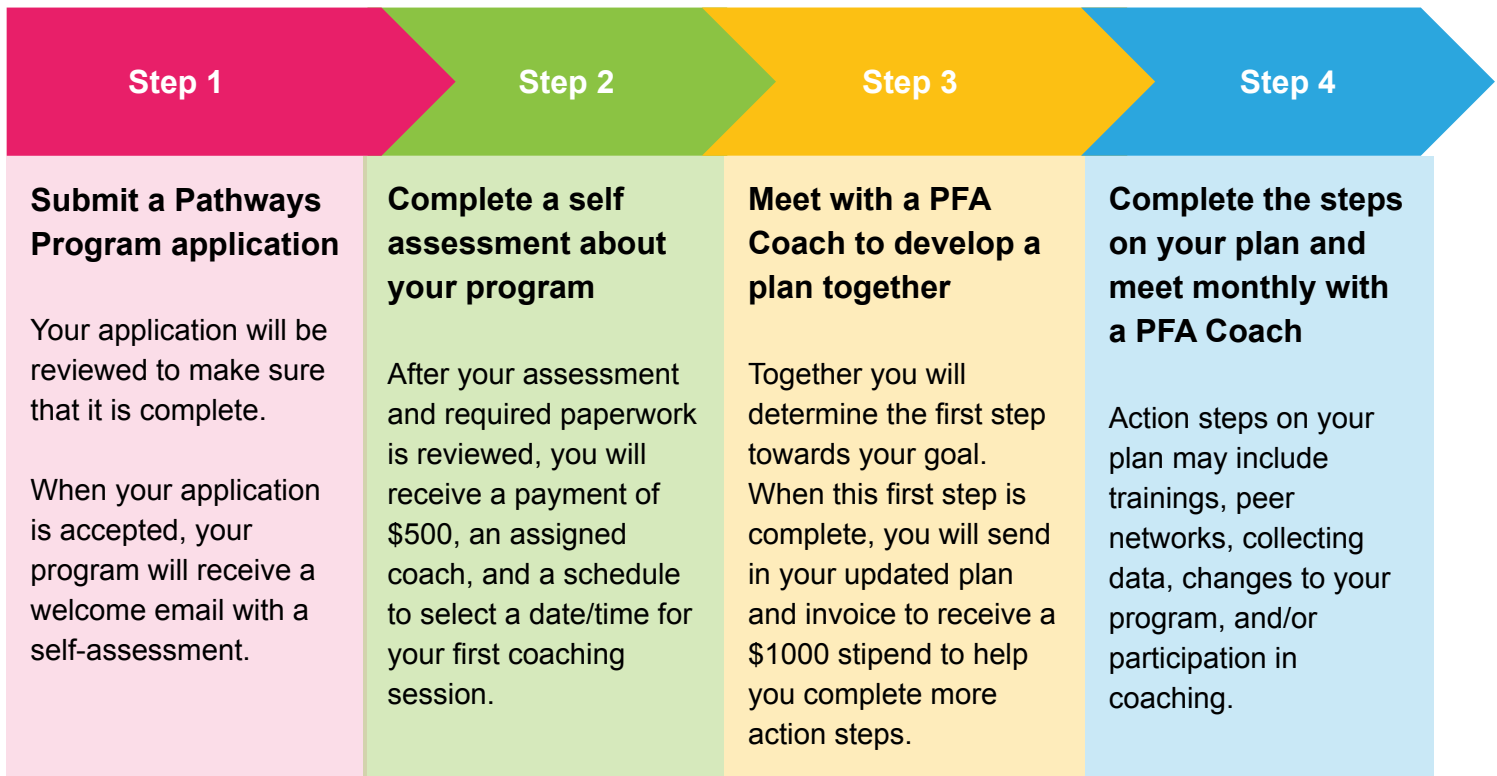
Preschool for All (PFA) includes home-based and center-based providers. The Pathways Program partners with preschool providers and educators to help them reach program and professional development goals. Pathways Providers participate in training and educational opportunities, business development, peer networks, and individualized coaching. Supports are based on the strengths and needs of each participant and are flexible to help providers and educators be at their best.



Pathways Program Details

Mt. Hood Community College Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) supports the Pathways Program and its participants through their team of coaches, training opportunities, and peer networks.

All preschool providers in Multnomah County are able to apply for the Pathways Program, no matter what their licensing status is, education level, or setting type. Pathways applications are open and available now. There is no deadline for applications to be submitted, providers can apply at any time.



Pathways Providers are not guaranteed Preschool for All slots. Slots are awarded through a separate application process each Fall. The Pathways Program is designed to help providers get ready to apply for Preschool for All slots.

The number of Preschool for All slots will grow each year, until the program reaches universal access in 2030.
