Do you also need health insurance?

We can help you apply. You may qualify for Oregon Health Plan or other programs. You do not need to have insurance to get care at Multnomah County clinics. If you are in need of reproductive health services (pap smears, birth control, STD screening) you may qualify for free or low cost care through the Oregon Reproductive Health Program.

Protection from Covid-19

Free testing, vaccines, and treatment available for Multnomah County Health Center patients

If you don't have a primary care provider, you may not know where to go for affordable Covid-19 testing and treatment. Our Health Centers are welcoming new patients and offer these services free of charge. Call 503-988-5558 for more information.



Vaccines

Free vaccines and booster shots for all age-eligible clients. Available at any Health Center or Student Health Center by appointment.



Testing

Free Covid testing by appointment for clients who have been exposed or have symptoms.



Prevention

Some people who are at high risk of severe illness from Covid-19 may benefit from additional preventative treatment that prevents illness and infection. These treatments are available to eligible Health Center patients at no cost.



Treatment

If you test positive for Covid-19 and have conditions that put you at higher risk, early treatment is available to help prevent severe illness. Treatment may be provided to people who are older age, immunocompromised, unvaccinated, and/or have other underlying conditions.

It is important to act quickly because the treatment must be started within 5 days of your first symptoms, and earlier is better. If you need treatment and don't have a primary care provider, our Health Center can fast-track your patient registration to help you get access to treatment.
