

2022-23 Family Information

On November 3rd, 2020 voters in Multnomah County overwhelmingly supported the "Preschool for All" ballot measure. Preschool for All (PFA) connects families in Multnomah County to free, inclusive, culturally responsive early education.

We are excited that you are considering preschool programs available through Preschool for All for your child. We know that choosing the right preschool for your child is an important decision.

When making a choice that meets your needs, keep in mind that all partnering programs use a curriculum that aligns with Oregon Early Learning and Kindergarten guidelines and employ staff who are committed to professional development and receive ongoing support. In addition, our preschool partners have agreed to:

- Create an environment of safety, trust, and belonging for all children and families, with a specific focus on the experiences of Black, Indigenous, and Families of Color
- Follow Preschool for All's policy of no suspensions or expulsions of children
- Fully include children with disabilities and/or special health needs
- Pay staff competitive wages and provide staff benefits
- Be licensed by the State of Oregon Office of Child Care (when required)

Preschool for All will have approximately 500 preschool seats available for the 2022-23 year. PFA will grow over time, increasing the number of providers and families, until it will be available to all interested families in Multnomah County in 2030.

There are just two eligibility requirements to participate. Children must:

- 1. Be 3 or 4 years old by September 1, 2022 and
- 2. Have a parent or legal guardian living in Multhomah County.

Children who currently have the least access to high-quality early learning experiences will be prioritized for the first available slots. Children whose families experience barriers accessing preschool include:

- Black, Brown, Native American Indigenous, and all Children of Color;
- Migrant and refugee children;
- Children who speak languages other than English;
- Children with developmental delays and disabilities;
- Children of teen parents, or in military families;

- Children living in foster care;
- Children from families affected by low incomes, homelessness, incarceration, substance abuse disorder, mental health diagnoses, and domestic violence.

Choosing the preschool that is right for you in three easy steps

Every family is unique and has different needs. Before choosing a program, you may want to consider making a list of things that are important to you, such as the location of the program, whether it's near public transportation, the hours, meals served, and other program details.

Please pay close attention to program offerings, such as hours and days the facility is open to make sure it works for your schedule. Some programs may close early, have planning days off, or operate on a school year calendar.

Please apply early. Applications open mid-April 2022 for the September 2022-2023 school year. We encourage families to submit their applications as soon as possible.

Preschool Setting Types

All PFA partners will meet basic program standards that align to the State of Oregon Office of Child Care licensing requirements for health and safety, staffing, and programming. Preschool for All requires home based and child care center providers to be licensed. The State does not require that school district preschools are licensed.

For more information regarding licensing and unlicensed program requirements you may contact the <u>Oregon Department of Education</u>, <u>Office of Child Care</u>.

Home-Based

Families choose home-based providers for different reasons:

- The home-like environment is appealing to many families.
- Family child care providers care for fewer children at one time than child care centers.
- Siblings can be together because most family child care homes have different ages of children enrolled.

- There are fewer adults that may care for your child on a daily basis.
- Family child care homes may be more flexible with their hours of operation compared to other types of care.

Center-Based

Some families prefer a center environment for their child. Families choose centers for different reasons:

- A larger setting in a commercial space is preferred.
- Children are in the same classroom with their peers.
- There are more adults/staff on site to provide oversight.
- There are a variety of teachers with various teaching styles.
- Some centers have larger outdoor play areas.

Schools and like settings

Other families choose a school setting for their children. Some reasons may include:

- Families may have older children who are enrolled in the same school.
- Preschool children become familiar with the school and when entering kindergarten, transition may be easier.
- Families like the wrap-around services and other support some schools offer.
- There are more adults/staff on site to provide oversight.
- The school is in their neighborhood.

There are many things to consider when choosing a preschool for your child and we wish you the best in finding the right program for your child.
