

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region 10 Training & Exercise Quarterly Compendium (TEQC) is published on a quarterly basis and contains basic information about regionally significant training and exercise events occurring in the next two (2) years.

The TEQC is a companion to the Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP) that identifies current priority core capabilities and upcoming training events to increase emergency management capabilities, regional preparedness, and to sustain operational readiness through the design and conduct of various training and joint exercises as part of the Plan-Train-Equip-Exercise preparedness cycle.

The next edition will be published in October 2022 and a call for updates will be distributed in late August 2022.

A regionally significant training or exercise event includes but is not limited to the following types of events:

- training which is open for enrollment by outside agencies;
- exercises in need of evaluators or controllers;
- exercises open to observers;
- multi-jurisdictional training and exercises;
- regional training and exercises; and
- training and exercises which an agency would like other regional partners to be aware of.
