#### League of Women Voters of Portland Recommendations

Based on League studies and member agreement, we support the following measures recommended by the Multnomah County Charter Review Committee.

#### Yes on Measure 26-232 - Ranked Choice Voting

- Ranked choice voting (RCV) provides more choices for voters who may rank candidates from most to least favorite. People can vote their conscience.
- The ranking process allows for just one election in November when voter turnout is higher and the electorate more accurately reflects Multnomah County's diversity.
- RCV is successful and increasingly used across the United States. Multnomah County voters are as smart as folks in those communities and will understand how RCV works.
- RCV gives voters more power to elect the candidates they prefer. If a voter's first choice doesn't win, their vote counts for their next-highest choice.

### Yes on Measure 26-230 – Gender Neutral Language

- The League supports equal rights for all and respectful government communications, as demonstrated by gender neutral language.
- There should be consistency between the use of gender neutral language in both county code and the charter.

### Yes on Measure 26-234 - Ombuds Position

An Ombuds position in the County Auditor's Office will facilitate governmental accountability.

#### Yes on Measure 26-235 - Auditor Access to Information

 The Auditor's capacity to ensure accountable, transparent government through audits and reports requires timely access to information.

#### Yes on Measure 26-236 - Charter Review Effectiveness

- Charter review by an independent committee is vital to keeping the county charter responsive to new issues or topics that were previously unanticipated.
- Charter Review Committee effectiveness requires adequate time, a reasonable budget, and an
  effective committee member selection process.

The measures proposed by the County Charter Committee not mentioned in this statement are neither supported nor opposed by LWV Portland due to the lack of a League study on which to base an endorsement decision.

RCV is well-known and used by more than 11 million Americans in cities, states, and counties around the United States. It already is being used in Oregon, in Benton County.

Research shows the many ways that RCV is better than what we use today:

- RCV creates <u>more civil political dialogue</u> and reduces negative campaigning and political polarization.
- RCV changes who runs, encouraging a <u>more diverse candidate pool</u> with more women and people of color not just running but also winning.
- RCV <u>saves money</u> because we don't have to run two separate elections to elect one person.

Ranked Choice Voting will help create a more diverse and more representative democracy for Multnomah County.
