The County Auditor cannot work for you effectively if county information is withheld or restricted from the Auditor. Vote Yes on 26-235 so the County Auditor will have unrestricted, timely access to county employees, information, and records.

While most county programs respond quickly to the County Auditor's information requests, that's not always the case. Delays have included:

- <u>Delayed access to data already reported to another agency.</u> In early 2022, a county department did not provide the Auditor with timely access to data that it already reports to a federal agency.
- <u>Delayed access to county information.</u> In early 2019, the county launched a new system for financial and human resources data. The Auditor started advocating for system access in 2017 well before the launch. It wasn't until the end of 2019 that the Auditor got adequate access to this data source used in nearly every audit.
- Restricted and delayed access. During a 2018 Animal Services follow-up audit, the director placed restrictions on the Auditor's access to the shelter and delayed access to data needed to complete the audit.

Vote Yes on Measure 26-235 to ensure the County Auditor's Office can access the information it needs to hold your government accountable.
