- a. The use of transient lodging is one of many approaches employed by the Joint Office of Homeless Services (JOHS) to address homelessness and related issues.
- b. Extending the lease located at 550 NW 6th Avenue (via the proposed "Third Amendment") will enable JOHS to continue operating an existing congregate shelter through at least the winter months of FY23.
- c. Approval of the Third Amendment in substantial conformance with the proposed terms is in the best interests of Multnomah County.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

- 1. Execution of the Third Amendment on terms substantially similar to those proposed is approved.
- 2. Renewals, extensions and amendments may be executed without further Board action.
