What is the overall deductible?	\$400 individual / \$1,200 family. Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. Examples of some services: In-network office visits, labs for certain chronic conditions, <u>hospice</u> <u>services</u> and prediabetes/diabetes self-management program as well as in and out-of-network spinal manipulation, naturopathic supplies, massage therapy, prescription medications, vision care and most <u>preventive care</u> are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . For medical services, \$2,000 individual / \$6,000 family, in-network and out-of-network combined; for prescription medications \$2,000 individual / \$6,000 family, in-network and out-of-network combined. What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?
