Candle Lighting Ceremony	Diane Quiring led the lighting of the ceremonial candle. On June 16 the US Dept of Human Services announced funding of nearly \$115M to help implement the Ending HIV Epidemic initiative. Key goals: reduce number of new HIV infections in US by 75% by 2025, by at least 90% by 2030. This would avert 250K HIV infections. Great for the future, but we have many people who have died - at least 700K in U.S. Today we remember people we have known personally or professionally who have died.
