- ★ National Parks Website LINK to ACCESS the PASS (ALL AGES) This is a Federal program for folks with a permanent disability that can apply to get a free access pass to Federal Parks and National Recreation lands. This is not specific for IDD folks, but any person with a permanent disability. U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the United States that have been medically determined to have a permanent disability (does not have to be a 100% disability) may get a free, lifetime pass that provides admittance to more than 2,000 recreation sites managed by five Federal agencies.
