- ★ Portland in January 2023
 - As I mentioned in my <u>When to Visit Portland post</u>, January isn't a huge month for events in Portland.
 - Here are a few:
 - Portland Old Time Music Gathering Jan 12-15, 2023. This, just as it sounds – old time music! – festival is scattered across the city at different venues each year.
 - Chinese New Year at Lan Su Chinese Garden January 22, 2023.
 Depending on the year January or February. There are always
 Chinese New Year festivities happening in Portland's Old
 Town/Chinatown and the Lan Su Chinese garden including the
 Lantern Viewing event.
 - Whale Watching on Oregon coast mid-December to mid-January is the seasonal winter migration of grey whales southbound. Best viewing spots are on central coast or from capes like on the <u>Three</u> <u>Capes Scenic Loop.</u>
