



January 2023	Community Education Phase Community Partner Engagement Workshops, Remove barriers to access, increase capacity modeling, contract process education, Program Model

Key terms in this presentation

RFPQ - Request For Programmatic Qualifications (Proposals).

"Mega RFPQ" - our nickname for the funding event: Community Services for Older Adults.

Culturally Specific - Agencies that provide services for specific populations to create an environment of belonging and safety in which services are delivered.

Culturally Responsive - Services provided in a way that is culturally responsive to the varied and intersecting identities of older adults and people with disabilities.



Of Importance about the RFPQ

 The RFPQ awards contracts to community organizations to deliver Older Americans Act Services for people 60+ in Multnomah County and other service for adults who are family caregivers and adults with disabilities
