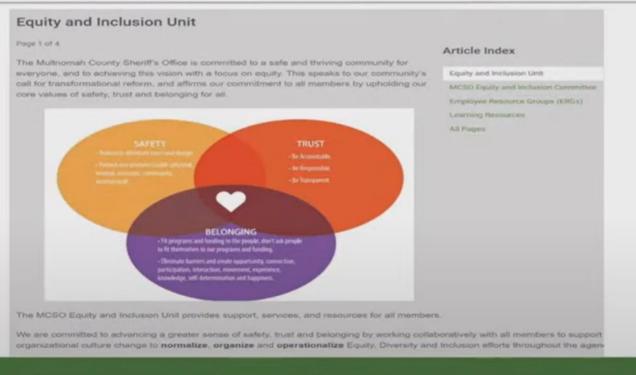

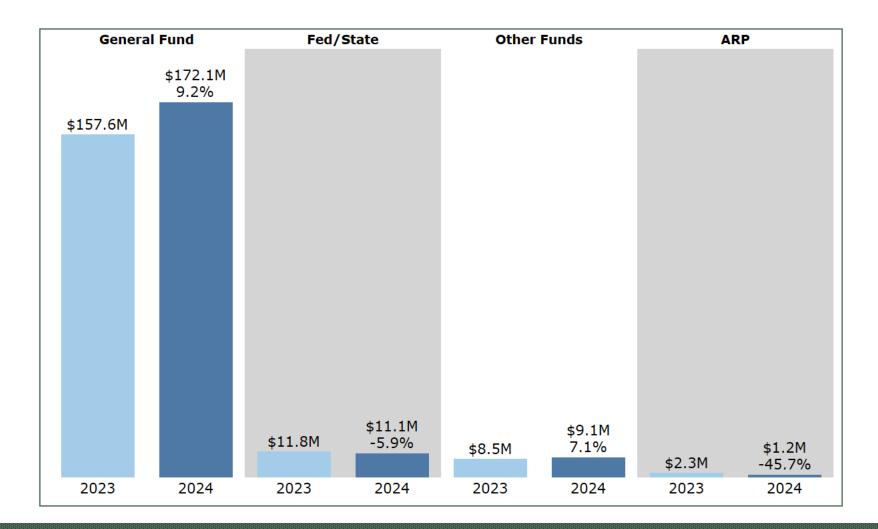

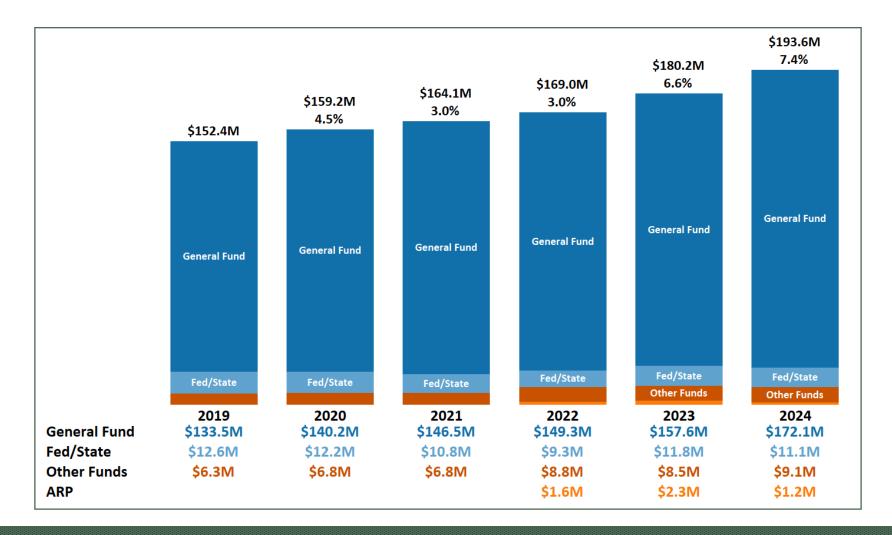

Budget By Fund - \$193,576,244



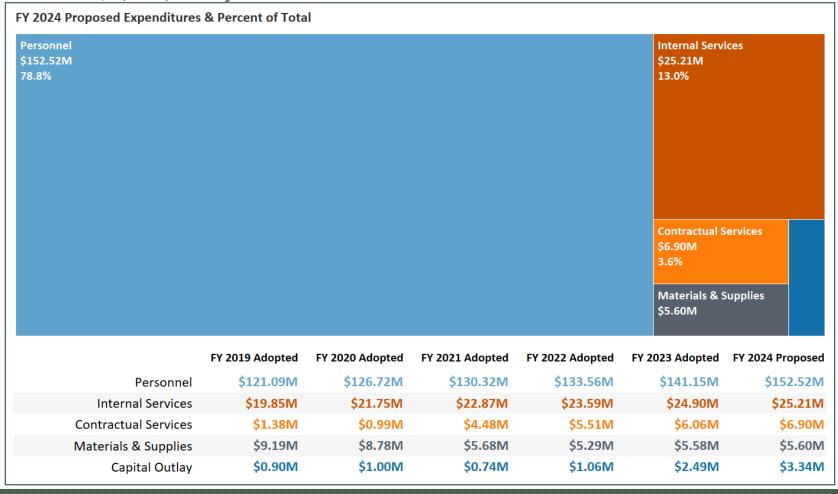
Significant Funds – 6 Year Trend

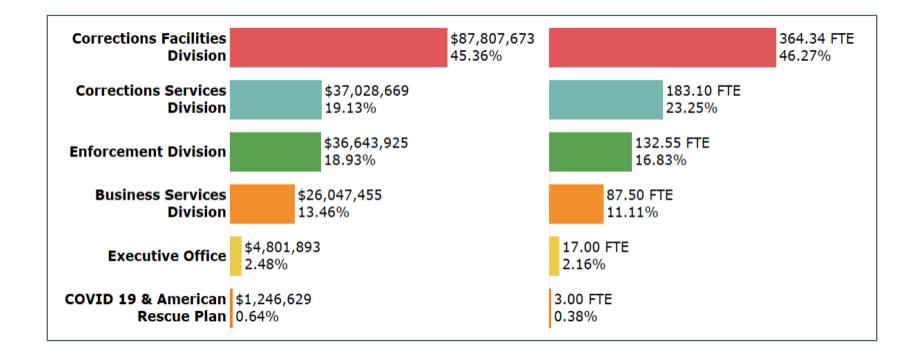


FY 2024 Proposed Budget by Division

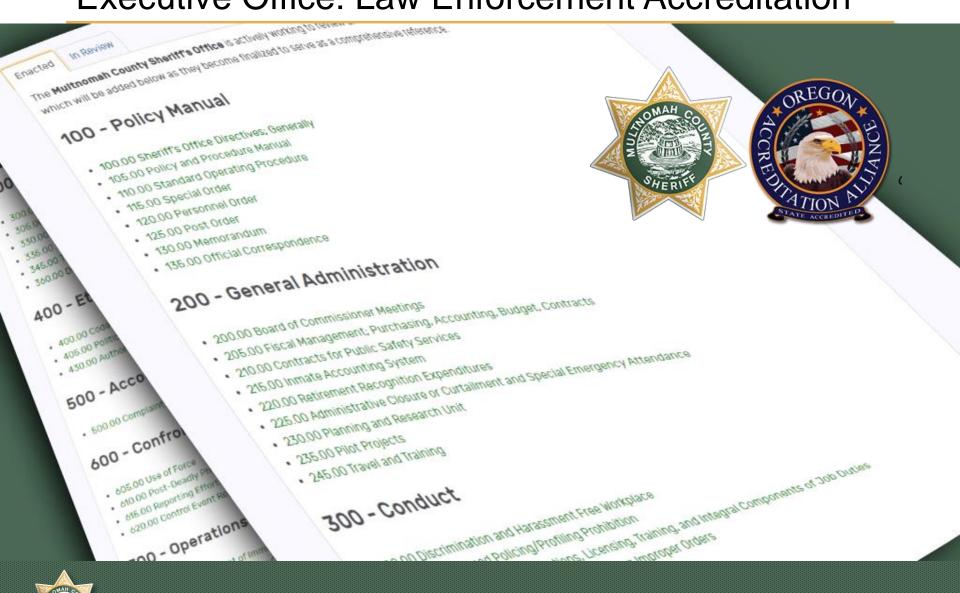

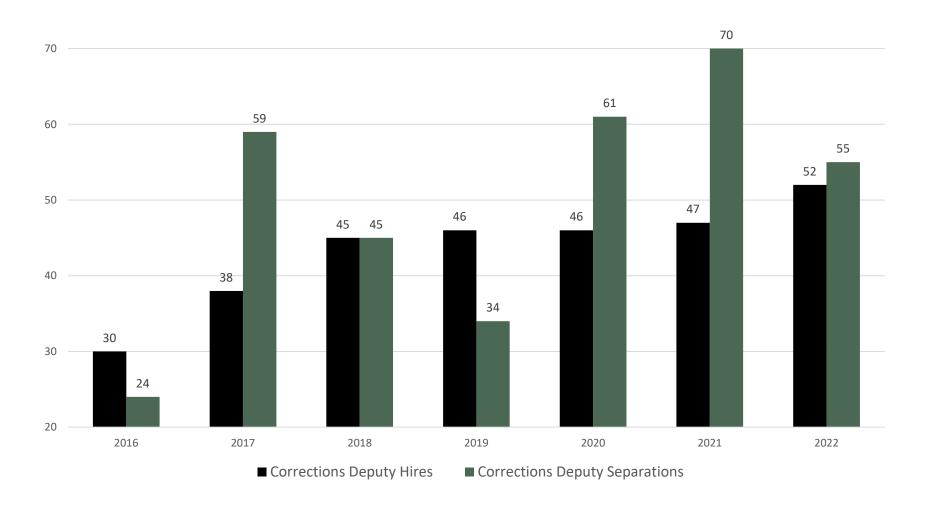

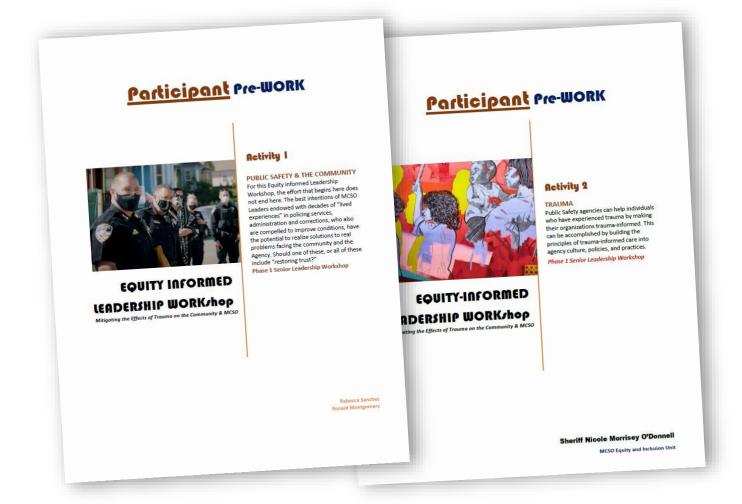

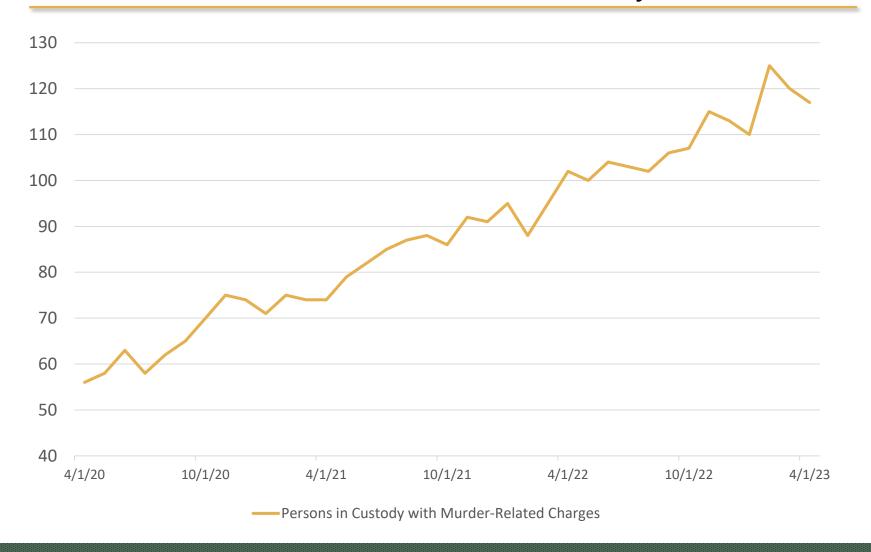

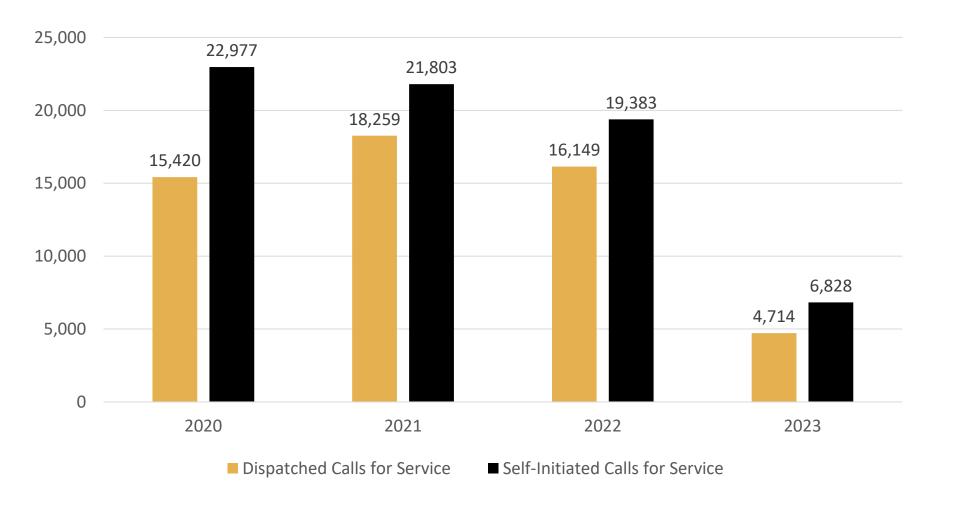

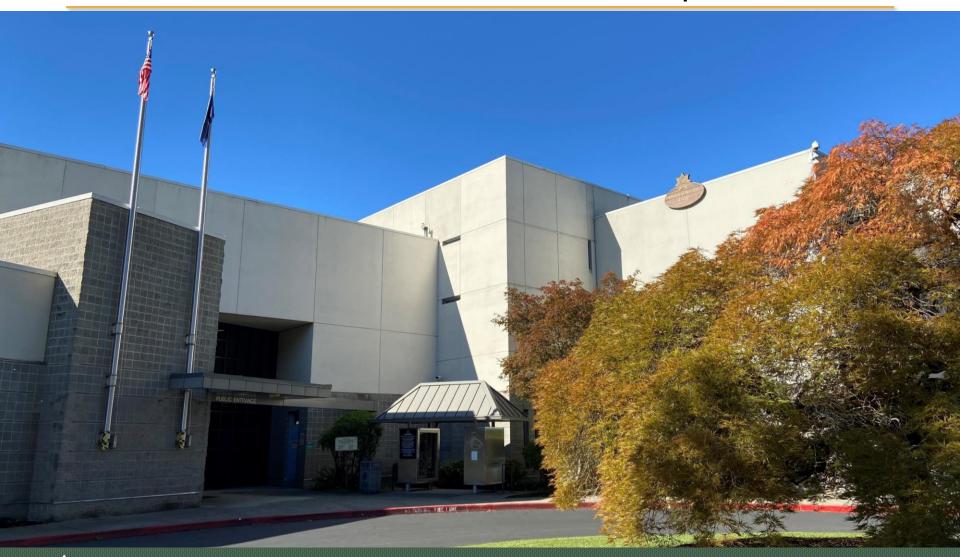
