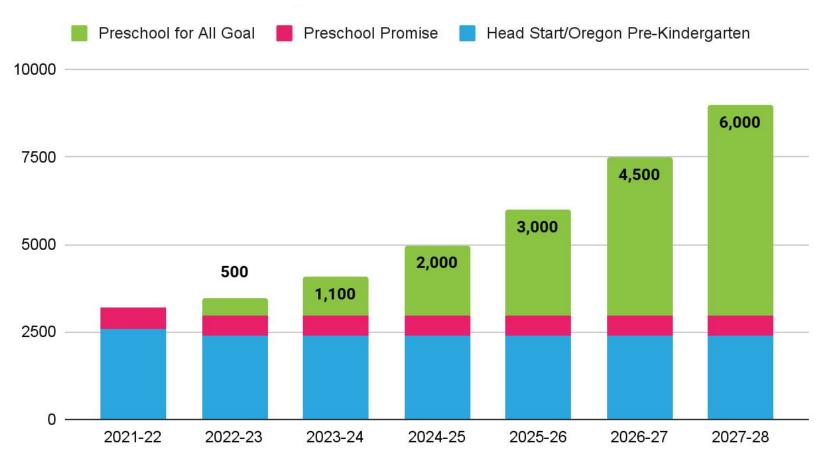

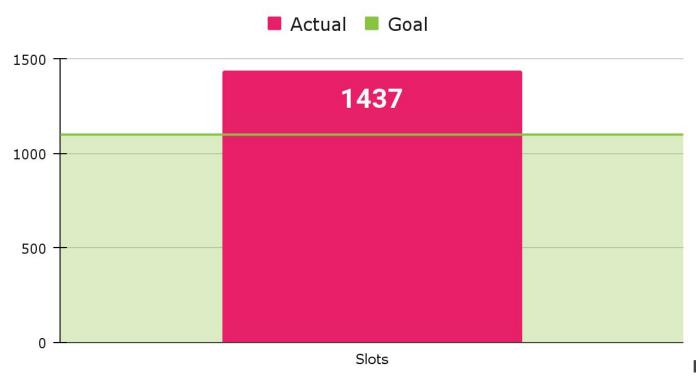


Slot Growth Over Time

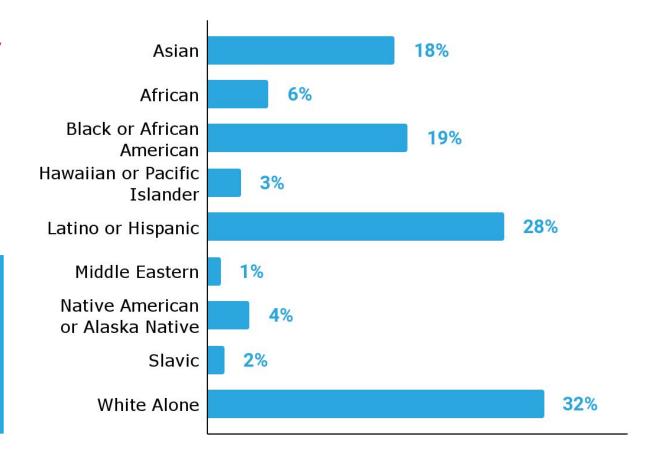

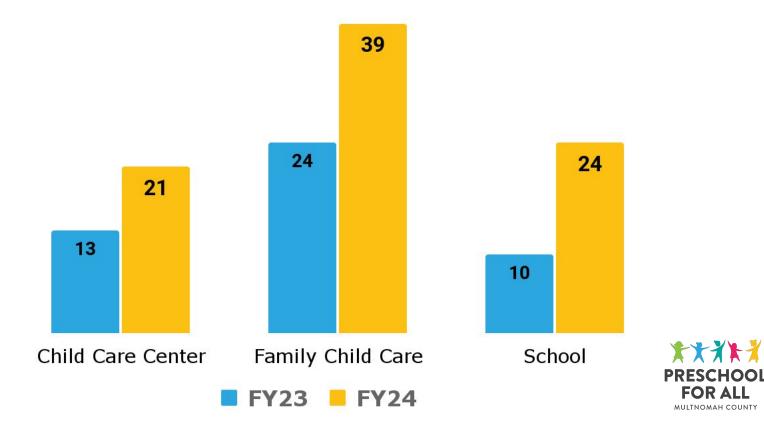
Inclusive Identity of Children Enrolled in PFA, Year One

68% of Children enrolled identify as Black, Indigenous, and People of Color

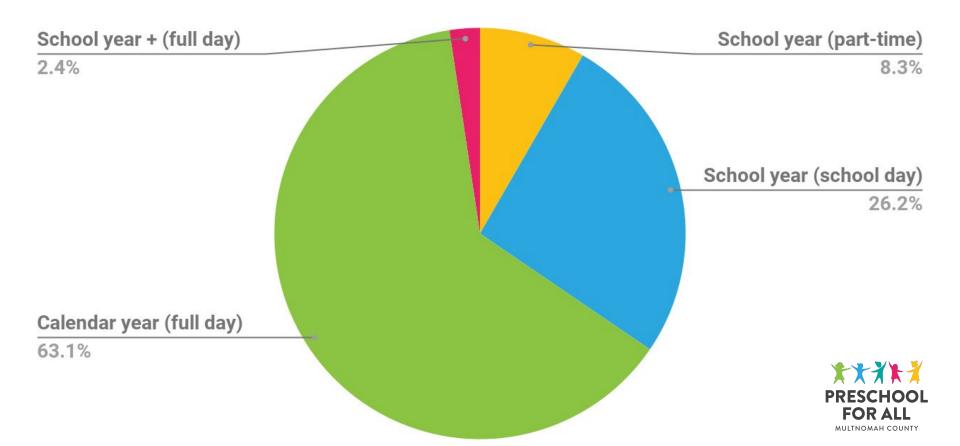

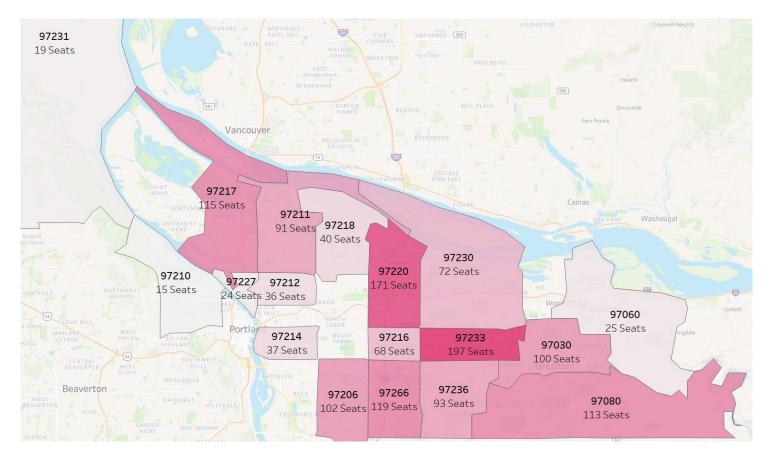

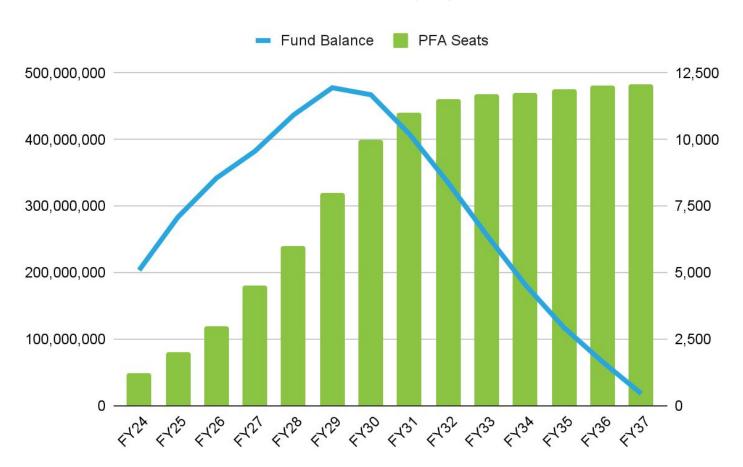

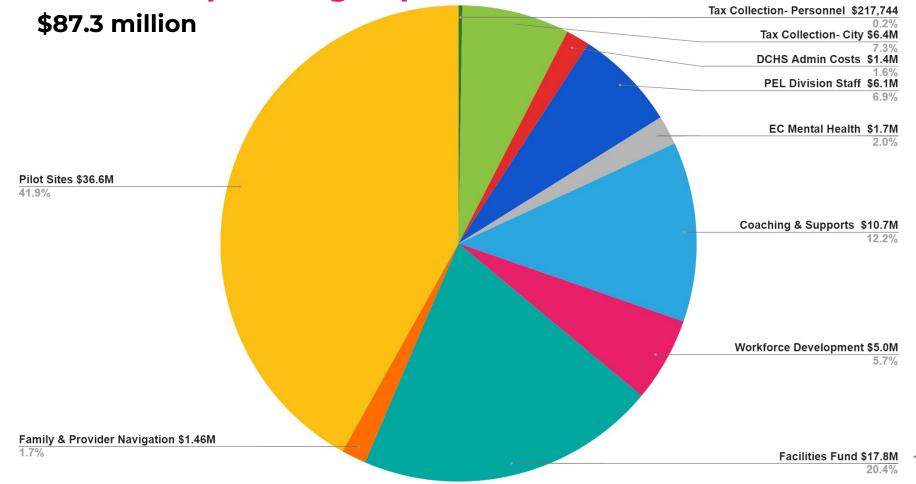

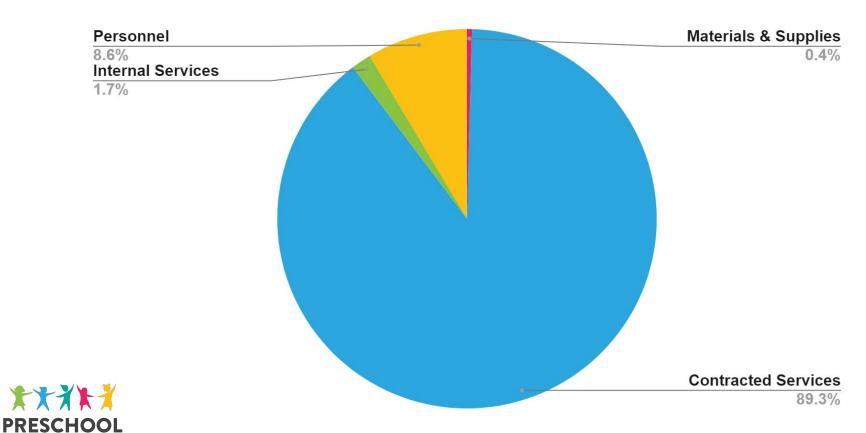

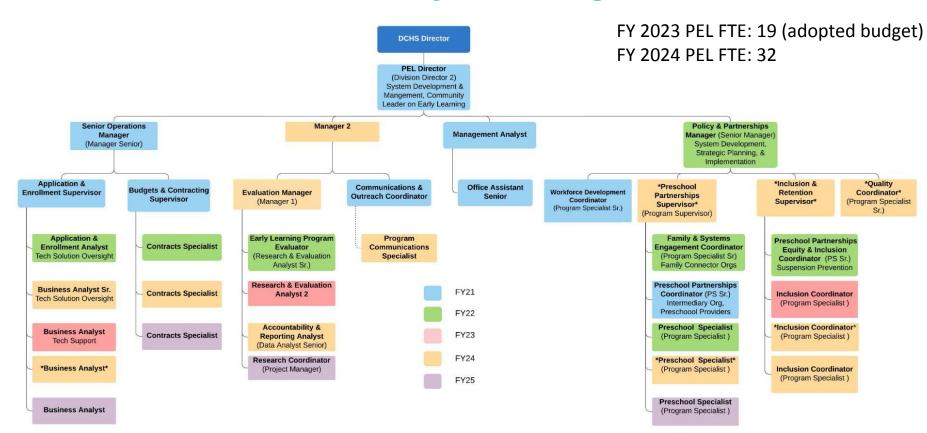

FY 2024 Operating Expenses by Category

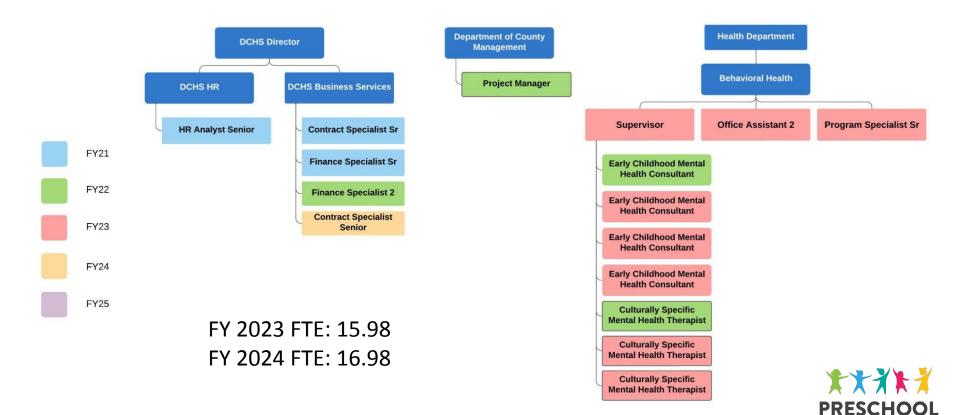
