Land Use Board Members - The PWB plan is way out of question.

The location is prime farmland. The current zone reflects this use. I have been told several times that the County does not "Spot Zone".

The location has country roads. On these roads I have seen:

- Bicycles or groups of bicycles
- Joggers and Hood to Coast relay runners (Bluff Road)
- Tractors moving adjacent locations
- Deer, rabbits and coyotes
- School buses

These roads do not lend themselves to the proposed construction traffic (over 1M fully loaded trucks during 5 year construction).

Two years ago the estimated cost was about \$1B. Now it is \$1.5B. Name the last project that came in under or even On budget. These numbers make this project out of PWB's league.

Many of the surrounding communities water districts are "opting out" of PWB due to this proposal.

The local community including almost every residence opposes this plant. I assume that the Board Members have seen the area and noted the number of signs reflecting opposition to this plant.
