## 2023 Budget Update

#### **BHD Highlights:**

- Bridge Team: Time limited treatment for individuals who are justice involved or at risk of justice involvement aimed to decrease hospitalization duration, hospital admittance, and jail diversion
- BHECN: \$2M allocation of opioid settlement funds for the Behavioral Health Emergency Coordination Network.
- BHRC Shelter: 33 bed, low-barrier shelter, opened May 15th
- BHRC Bridge Housing: 19 bed, 90-day bridge housing program, staggered opening beginning July 1st
- County General Fund will be provided to continue two programs initially lifted by ARPA
  - o Gun Violence Impacted Families Behavioral Health Response Team
  - o Old Town Inreach Program

#### Self-care

- Principles before personalities
- Limit comments to two minutes
- Limit acronyms and jargon
- Interrupt conversations that cause harm

#### Virtual meeting reminders

- Try not to talk over each other raise hand; use chat; accommodate people on the phone and tech issues
- Silence microphones when not speaking
- Go off camera when necessary

- Hold space, make space; Remember WAIT (Why Am I Talking?) and "Principles before Personalities"
- Stay engaged to the best of your ability
- Share your experience & hear the experience of others Use "I statements"
- Acknowledge intent and center impact
- Expect and accept non-closure
- Experience discomfort (creating a safer space for challenging conversations can be uncomfortable at times)
- Name and account for power dynamics in the the work
- We are here to work collaboratively, and share responsibility for the success of our work together
