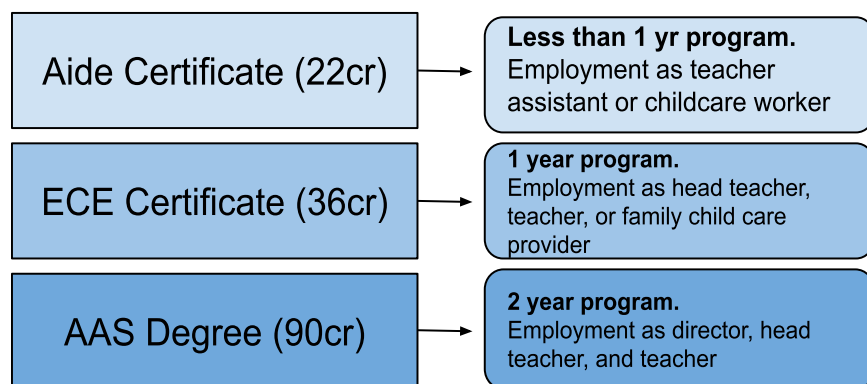

- development and plan activities and environments appropriate for each child's unique abilities and interests.

## Program Pathways & Outcomes

Credits for each certificate builds toward the Associates of Applied Science Degree (AAS).



The AAS in ECE may be used to transfer to PSU (B.A. Child, Youth & /Family Studies) or SOU (B.A. Early Childhood Development) through PCC's transfer articulation agreement.

## Now Offering: Bilingual Instruction & Scholarship!

Beginning in Fall 2023, PCC's ECE program is now able to offer dual-language Spanish ECE courses.

This programming includes:

- Full-time AAS Degree or 36 credit Certificate or Part-time 36 credit certificate
- 100 level courses bilingual instruction / 200 level courses- Spanish materials/English instruction
- Completion by Fall 2025
- All tuition/fees/textbooks covered
- Bilingual ECE Navigator/Advisor & Student Support Specialist
