Service Area & Target Groups/Focus

Children, adults and families who are homeless, living in poverty and/or at risk of academic failure – primarily from school neighborhood, but services are open to anyone.

School Population: 570 students; Grades 6-8; 38% Free and Reduced Lunch; 44% Students of Color (African American II%, American Indian/Alaskan Native I%, Asian 2%, Hispanic 22%, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander 0%, Multiple Race 7%, White 56%)

Evaluation

157 youth served

83% students of color

65% identified as being "at risk of academic failure"

53% qualified for free and reduced lunch

16,819 people served in non-enrollment events (family educational nights, cultural fairs, etc.)

64% of students increased benchmark scores in Reading*
79% of students increased benchmark scores in Math*
Average daily attendance of SUN CS students was 83%

Community and variety are the heartbeat of the Beaumont SUN Community School Extended Day and evening programs. Students have the opportunity to seek academic assistance at either AM & PM Study Hall. Extended Day Clubs such Skate & Study help students allot time for both schoolwork and athletics. Books & Bagels, Chess, Lunch Recess Club and Creative Writing allow students to creatively engage in academic pursuits

Beaumont students gain leadership skills through Leadership Improv and Business Club. Art, Drama, Cheerleading, and Dance clubs get students' creative juices and bodies moving. Students explore technology through Multimedia, Computer Club, and School Newspaper Club. We also support healthy lifestyles and teamwork through numerous recreational and competitive sport teams for students — everything from Ping Pong and Cheerleading to Basketball and Dodgeball!
