

**Multnomah County Voter-Approved Temporary Income Tax**  
**Brief summary of county programs funded and clients served**  
July 2003 – June 2004

**Aging and Disability Services** **\$2,693,950**

- In-home assistance for seniors with so they may remain in their homes
- Prescription drug assistance for low-income seniors and people with disabilities
- Medical transportation for low-income seniors
- Housing for seniors and people with disabilities who are homeless

**Health Care Services** **\$3,092,555**

- Oregon Health Plan payments to prevent low-income clients from losing health care coverage
- Communicable disease control and prevention (ie, West Nile, Tuberculosis, etc.)
- Basic dental services
- Food vouchers and nutrition education for low-income pregnant women and infants

**Mental Health and Developmental Disability Services** **\$7,958,415**

- Operation of urgent walk-in clinics, a mobile response unit, and a crisis call center
- Treatment for low-income patients who have lost Oregon Health Plan coverage
- Counselors in schools
- Case managers for developmental disability clients

**Alcohol and Drug Treatment Services** **\$3,757,635**

- Outpatient alcohol and drug treatment
- Chemical abuse rehabilitation services – Hooper Detox
- Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUI) services

**Prosecution and Court Services** **\$2,395,395**

- Prosecution of felonies, violent person to person crimes, and repeat property offenses
- Prosecution of misdemeanors, prostitution, and criminal trespass violations
- Operation of community courts and supervision of work crews

**Juvenile Justice and Crime Prevention Services** **\$1,790,123**

- Prosecution of juvenile delinquency and dependency cases
- Supervision of high-risk juveniles on probation
- Gang outreach and prevention services

**Jail Operations and Adult Offender Supervision** **\$9,122,323**

- Incarceration of offenders who have committed repeat property and person to person crimes
- 5 parole and probation officers to supervise adult offenders
- Alcohol and drug treatment at secure residential facilities for offenders under supervision
- Operation of alcohol and drug diversion alternatives (STOP Court and Clean Court)

**Law Enforcement** **\$1,153,952**

- Enforcement of anti-narcotic and anti-DUI laws and traffic safety
- Investigation of child abuse cases

**Total:** **\$31,964,348**
