Performance Measures Reported with FY2008-09 Program Offers

Reported by Liang Wu, Budget Office Evaluation (March 2008)

As of February 28, a total of 1,331 performance measures (PM) were reported*, representing the 454 program offers submitted for the FY 2008-09 budget year. Among programs with at least one reported measure, the average number of PM was 2.9. Twenty-one program offers did not submit performance measure (see appendix 1).

Type of Performance Measure. Over 90% of measures were either output or outcome measures.
