











Notes: The average daily Health Clinic Visits decreased 14% from March. The average daily ADS help line calls decreased 10% and Mental Health Crisis help line calls showed a steady upward trend; however, DV Crisis Call data was unavailable for the month of April. The average daily inpatient bed days per 1000 Verity members increased to 11 from March's average of 8.7; and bed days per discharge increased to 7.6 from 6.2 in March.









Notes: The number of ADS clients showed a slight decrease of 2% in caseloads over March while DD clients continued their trend to increase. The total number of closed investigations increased 42% led by an increase in ADS cases. The daily average Youth Shelter population and homeless clients served by ADS increased slightly over February. Mental Health outpatient and part of homeless services data were still not available for the March update.
