











Notes: Inpatient bed days per 1,000 Verity enrollees were down from 15.4 in June to 10.6 in July. Percentage of school-based clinic visits substantially decreased due to the summer vacation. The daily average ADS and DV helpline calls remained unchanged while the mental health crisis line calls continued to increase in July. Mental health E-hold commitment rate was slightly up too.









Notes: The number of families/individuals receiving rental assistance decreased while the number of vouchers issued increased in July—an opposite direction as compared to the previous month. The daily average of DD & ADS PS new investigations decreased in July. A&D TX enrollment has been steady and successful completion rate stayed above 50% since last November.
