





Multnomah County Health Clinic Visits












Mental Health Verity Inpatient Days










Multnomah County Addictions Treatment












Notes: The number of families and individuals receiving rental assistance significantly increased based on updated April data. This increase was largely due to the fiscal year end spending-down. The number of new A&D treatment enrollments continued to decline, however completion rates increased, exceeding 50% in November and December of 2004. There is a slight delay in the Shelter and Emergency Housing Assistance data—voucher and rental assistance data are from April 2005.
