

Notes: For Average Daily Adult caseloads, Cases Received increased to 70, the first increase since September. The DA averaged for 2008, 123 cases a month with Court Processing having a 50% conviction rate. Starting 2009, total cases and percent convicted increased 3%. Adult Active Caseload dropped to 8,781, continuing the decline of the past four months. Also, Juvenile Justice Caseload by Unit increased for the first time in four months to a total of 566. This result increased the average caseload per counselor to 25.7. CFS and RST Adult Caseloads continue their two month decline.
