











Notes: Average Daily Reported Offenses went down 8.4% from July to August at 98 per day. This change was primarily from decreases in Theft and Auto Theft crimes. Average Daily Arrests increased by 1% from the previous month with a continued decline in the Property category from its peak in April. This decrease was counteracted by increases in other categories. Average Daily Population continues to decrease; dropping from 1409 in July to 1381 with a 89.7% utilization rate.









Notes: Average Daily Received Cases decreased 12.3% from July to August, down to 71. This was its lowest level since December 2007. The decrease was primarily due to drops in the Local Charge, Person, and Property categories. After the high level of Average Daily Adult Court Outcomes in July the Total Cases Closed and number of Convictions decreased to more conventional levels.
