











Notes: Reported offenses have declined considerably since their April peak (124/day) due mostly to reduction in the *theft* and *auto theft* categories. The Average Daily Bookings declined substantially due to decreases in *local*, *vehicle*, and *property* offenses. Standard Booking is at its lowest level since January averaging 86 per day. This decrease is driven by decreases in the *Property*, *Alcohol*, and *Other* charge categories.









Notes: District Attorney Caseload data is currently unavailable. The remaining three categories remain stable for September.
