











**Notes:** There was a slight increase in reported offenses: the largest increase being in auto theft. The average daily arrests also slightly increased over February, mainly in the 'Other' category. The Average Daily Jail Population continues to drop, from 1618 in February to 1546 in March, resulting in an increase in available jail beds.









**Notes**: A leveling of cases closed occurred in March with Vehicle/DUII crimes falling and property related crimes rising. There was an increase in the number of Adult Community Supervision caseloads in March and a decrease in the number of Juvenile Supervision caseloads with little change in distribution by type.
