











Notes: December showed a 7.7% decrease in Standard bookings along with Cite and Identify bookings. The number of Turn Self In bookings continued to increase. The MCSO reported 18 matrix releases in December (avg. <1 /day). There are historically fewer matrix releases in December. The Average Length of Stay (ALS) increased by 1 day to 18.9 days per booking. There were 61 beds available on any given day in December.









Notes: The DA Adult Cases Received continued to decline; December declined in all offense categories. The Adult Supervision caseload decreased in December due to drops in the *Specialized* and *Reduced Supervision Team (RST)* caseloads. Juvenile Justice Caseload increased slightly due to an increase *High-Medium* caseloads.
