











**Notes:** Average daily arrests decreased by 8.7% compared to last month. Average daily arrests decreased primarily due to a decrease in *Other* arrests. The MCSO reported 175 matrix releases in October (avg. 5.6/day) and the average length of stay (ALS) remained stable (17 days per booking). October's overall jail utilization was 99.4%, leaving only 9 beds available on any given day.









**Notes**: The Active Adult Caseload increased in October by 8%. Increases were shown in DV and AAP cases. Juvenile justice caseloads increased in September.
