











Notes: Reported Index Offenses remain significantly lower than at this time last year; Portland and Gresham report a 17% and 18% reduction, respectively. However, reported *Robbery* is higher than last year for both cities. Average daily arrests declined (-15%) over June with a related decline in average daily *Standard Bookings* (-8%). The average length of stay per booking (ALS) dropped to 16.5 days. The lower ALS and fewer bookings reduced matrix release levels in July to 197 (avg. 6.4/day).









Notes: Following declines in arrest volume, the DA's average daily *cases received for prosecution* declined 15%. The adult community supervision total caseload dropped by 6%; there was a reduction in the *Reduced Supervision Team*, *Specialized* and *Non-Specialized* caseloads, -12% and -4%, respectively. The decrease reflects a 25% reduction in funding for misdemeanor probation supervision restricting the number and type of cases now placed on formal probation.
