











Notes: The Average Daily Reported Part I Offenses increased, due to increases in *Property Crimes* for both PPB and GPD. Year-to-date reported Part I Offenses are more than -6% lower than last year. Average Daily *Standard Bookings* declined, remaining above the multi-year average. The MCSO reported 447 matrix releases in October (avg. 14.4/day), comparable to September. The Average Length of Stay (ALS) decreased substantially to 13 days, a decline of 3 days from September.









Notes: The DA Adult Cases Received remained largely the same as September. The Adult Supervision declined overall: increases in the Reduced Supervision Team and Non-Specialized but a large decrease in Specialized (i.e., Domestic Violence, Clean Court, and Gangs). Juvenile Justice Caseload increased due to increases in all three risk-level cases. The average per counselor caseload was 3 cases more than 1 year ago at this time.
