


\*The graph reflects the combined weekly index offenses data from Portland Police Bureau (PPB) and Gresham Police Dept (GPD), beginning 8/2004 (line in **blue**). PPB and GPD account for 94% of all offenses county-wide. Index offenses account for about half of all reported offenses.


Average Daily Reported Index Offenses\*

Average Daily Arrests: January 2005




**Notes:** Average Daily Reported Index Offenses declined, due to reduced theft (all types) for PPB. Average Daily Arrests declined by 19 from December 2004. The number of arrests in each charge type is very similar to the level of January 2004. Average Daily Bookings were slightly lower (by 4) than the multi-year average. Matrix releases (391) increased by 50% from December 2004, averaging 12.5 per day.

**Notes**. The DA adult caseloads declined in all crime types except Property and Person. Adult Supervision caseloads increased slightly due to increases in the specialized caseload (Gender Specific & Sex Offender). The juvenile caseload levels remained consistent.
