

## PUBLIC SAFETY BRIEF: DECEMBER 2003





## **Notes:**

There was a drop in the daily average number of reported index crimes due to decreases in theft from autos, shoplifting, and other larcenies.

The average daily bookings dropped from 95 to 87; the largest decrease was in the average number of holds. The average daily custody population dropped from 1678 to 1629, freeing up the most beds since July 2003.



## **Notes:**

There was a recent decline in the number of cases received by the District Attorney's Office. This decline coincided with an MIS changeover. The charge details for cases received are currently unavailable. There was an increase in specialized CFS adult supervision caseloads; the largest category increase was in sex offender cases.

Juvenile Community Supervision caseloads dropped. The multi-year trend graph now contains diversion cases. The dramatic decrease observed in late 2001 was due to a budget reduction. The pie chart reflects reorganization, gender specific cases (females only) have been added and North GRIT cases are now served by GRIT.
