


## Multnomah County: Arrests (PPB, MCSO, & Fairview)









## Notes:

There were no changes in the average daily number of reported index crimes compared to September. The daily average remains above the multiyear average due to an increase in reported property crimes. Average daily bookings compared to the *revised* September data (103) showed little change. There was an increase in the proportion of pre-trial felony inmates; the largest increase for this group was observed in serious person crimes (e.g. homicide, weapons charges, assault).





#### Notes:

There was a notable decrease in adult supervision cases (368) due to a reduction in the casebank caseloads. Juvenile supervision high and medium risk caseload increased, driven by an increase in medium risk cases while a corresponding decrease in low/undefined risk cases, resulted in a little change in overall caseload.
