



#### Change in Race and Ethnicity from 1990 to 2000












#### One Race: White Alone




### White Density by Neighborhood




#### One Race: Black or African American Alone




#### Black Density by Neighborhood




#### One Race: American Indian and Alaska Native Alone






### Asian Density by Neighborhood




#### One Race: Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander Alone


