



Calibrating a Probe Thermometer

When calibrating a thermometer, handle it gently, because rough handling or dropping will cause it to lose calibration.

When:

Calibrate each thermometer frequently:

- Weekly or at least once a month •
- After it has been dropped •

How:

- Fill a medium glass with ice. 1.
- 2. Add water.
- 3. Place thermometer in ice.
- 4. Wait a few minutes.
- 5. After a few minutes, thermometer should read 32° F.

If thermometer does not read 32° F:

- 1. Leave thermometer in water.
- 2. Using pliers to turn hex nut until needle reads 32° F.
- 3. Wait a few minutes.
- Repeat step 2 if thermometer still isn't reading 32° F. 4.
