

Dear Mr. McBride:

Foss Environmental Services is pleased to submit the following proposal for in-situ decommissioning of one underground storage tank (1000 gl) at 4420 SE 64th, Portland, Oregon:

SCOPE OF WORK

- Foss will mobilize to the site with necessary equipment and personnel and be responsible for utility locates
- A tailgate safety meeting will be performed
- The asphalt and tank will be drilled to facilitate addition of control density fill
- The tank will be emptied, triple rinsed, and the liquids pumped into a 70 bbl vacuum truck
- The liquids will be transported to a local disposal/recycling facility for proper disposal
- Control density fill will be introduced into the tank
- Above ground vent tube will be removed
- Foss will generate a final report on the project

COST PROPOSAL

- Labor, materials, and equipment

\$ 3,160.00 (lump sum)

- Disposal of liquids

\$ 0.35/gallon

- Disposal of sludges (if any)

\$ 1.50/gallon

ASSUMPTIONS

- Water and electricity are available on site

- Tank is non-regulated and was used for heating fuel storage
- Sampling and analytical is not included in the proposal, but can be quoted upon request if required
- Disposal costs are based upon final acceptance by the disposal facility
- The UST is 1,000 gallons or less

Due to the location of the tank and the large tree nearby, we feel that the tank would be most cost effectively decommissioned in-place. Upon acceptance of our proposal, please call Rich Janecek to schedule the work. Currently, the week of August 28th would fit our schedule. Per our telephone conversation this morning, Foss would like to further explain our proposal regarding our bid to decommission the UST at 4420 SE 64th, Portland. Since the UST was apparently used for heating fuel storage and is therefore non-regulated, sampling around the tank should not be necessary unless there is evidence of a release to the surrounding environment and our bid, subsequently, did not allow for sampling. If required or requested, Foss will perform the sampling and labwork for a cost of \$ 1,440.00.
