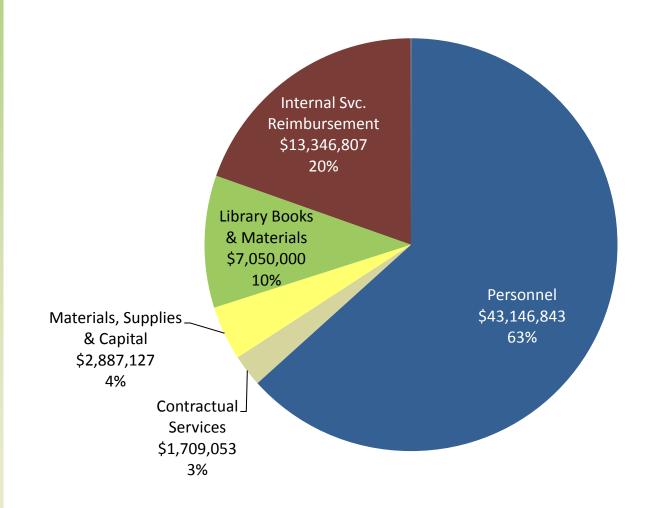

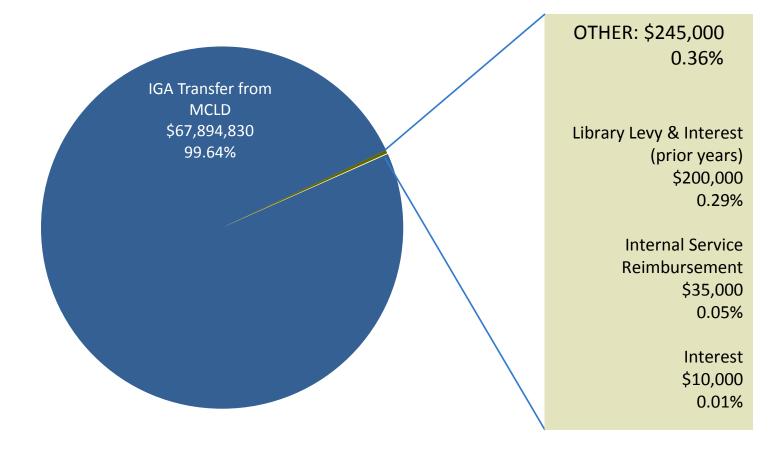


Budget by Spending Category
