The Adult Care Home Program (ACHP) licenses, monitors, and regulates Adult Care Homes in Multnomah County. There are 620 homes that provide 24-hour care for persons with physical, mental, and developmental disabilities and seniors not able to perform activities of daily living. Adult Care Homes offer affordable quality care in homelike, culturally appropriate settings and serve approximately 2,750 disabled and elderly individuals. Our mission is to ensure the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the Adult Care Home and to promote the highest level of independence possible for each resident residing in the Adult Care Home.

Job Functions /Duties

This position is responsible for monitoring the activities and services delivered in Adult Care Homes. The monitor also assists the licenser in determining if licensing requirements are being met by Adult Care Home operators. Monitors conduct home visits, interviewing residents in Adult Care Homes to determine if their health, welfare, and safety are adequately protected. Monitors also coach and teach operators and caregivers through one-on-one technical assistance to support providers in providing excellent care and to ensure their compliance with the Multnomah County Administrative Rules.
