Department solicitation and Department or Division description:

The Multnomah County Health Department Healthy Birth Initiatives (HBI) REACH Project is seeking qualified candidates for a temporary position working to support project activities. The HBI REACH Project utilizes a culturally specific approach to addressing health disparities that impact African Americans in Multnomah County. The project focuses on improving nutrition and food access and environments with healthy food and beverage options to decrease disparities in chronic disease and increasing tobacco and smoke-free environments.

Job Task Description:

This position will assist program staff in working to achieve project outcomes. Tasks will include outreach and recruitment for project activities, working to develop project visuals such as charts and graphics, the development of videos supporting project work, support of policy analysis and recommendations, and community assessment activities.

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities Required:

- Knowledge of effective use of social media
- The ability to use logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems.
