Additional information

On-the-Job Training - Worksource Portland Metro: Helps local businesses train and retain positions that require unique skills sets. WorkSource representative works with business to develop position description, recruit candidates, and create a training plan once a candidate is identified. To offset the cost of training, WorkSource reimburses companies for their training investment at 50% of wages paid to the new hire during the training period. At the end of the training period, the business is reimbursed for half of the OJT commitment, and receives the other half after 90 days.

Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries - Apprenticeship & Training: Program allows veterans to use their G.I. Bill benefits to receive a monthly tax-free stipend when a veteran is employed in an occupation by an employer or organization that is approved to train veterans. The stipend amount varies per veteran, on average a veteran will receive \$17,480 a year in benefits if they maintain full time status with their employer and the Department of Veteran's Affairs. An OJT or Apprenticeship program provides a veteran with a structured and stable work environment and contributes to a strong retention rate for veterans in the work force, which benefits the business as well. <u>Work Opportunity Tax Credit - WorkSource Oregon</u>: Save money on federal taxes by hiring eligible Veterans. The amount of your tax savings varies depending on the Veterans you hire and the length of their employment. For example, you might be able to get a tax break up to \$9,600 if you hire a disabled veteran.
