
Risk Tools in Criminal Justice

Used to predict behavior to make decisions about case management

Items based on theory and research and use an actuarial approach

Based on a defined set of factors and tend not to include infrequent factors Frequently combined with policy override options

Assessment Tools for Adult Offenders




Static Tool: Historical factors (such as age at first offense, prior criminal history)


Dynamic Tool: Changeable risk factors (such as employment & substance use)

Example of Static Tool


Public Safety Checklist Classification Rates Sample from 2000-2005




LSCMI: Where would you put boundaries to separate this line into risk categories?



Policy Versus Risk Holds


