




#### Federal, State, and County Roles








#### Total 2013 Compensation and Pension

### **3 OUT OF 10** VETERANS HAVE ACCESSED THEIR FEDERAL BENEFITS






Looking Ahead // Ongoing Services



#### Veterans Services Office ADVSD - Veteran's State and CGF Total Budget






