## **Definitions:**

- <u>Production</u> means the manufacture, planting, cultivation, growing or harvesting of marijuana is Oregon
- Processing means the processing, compounding, or conversion of marijuana into cannabinoid products, concentrates or extracts; excludes packaging or labeling
- Wholesaling means purchasing marijuana items in Oregon for resale to a person other than a consumer in Oregon
- Retail/dispensary means selling marijuana items to a consumer in Oregon

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> HB 3400A - Section 14 (3) – County may allow the production of marijuana as a farm use on land zoned for farm or forest use

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> 215.283(1)(r) allows for a facility for the processing of farm crops, if farm operation provides at least one-quarter of the farm crops and is less 10,000 square feet of floor area.

The County needs to determine whether RR zones are considered Farm/Forest or if they fit the definition of an area zoned exclusively for residential use

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> The production/growing of Medical Marijuana could be allowed as a home occupation subject to the standards that apply to all home occupations

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Retail Marijuana and Medical Marijuana Dispensaries may not be located within 1,000 of a public, private, or parochial elementary, or secondary school.
