
## **VISION & MISSION**



#### OJJDP Definition of a GOAL:

- General statements of desirable outcomes
- Desired END, not MEANS to the end
- Determine overall direction, not specific activities

#### OJJDP Definition of an OBJECTIVE:

- Specific statements of desired outcome (without detailed information about the process)
- Measurable
- Time-bound

#### **SAMPLE GOAL:**

Alleviate community residents' fear of gang activity.


#### **SAMPLE OBJECTIVE:**

Reduce the level of gangrelated property crime in the target area by 20%, as measured by law enforcement crime data and community residents' perceptions, by the end of Year One of the project.


Coordinate systems of care and public safety using a trauma-informed approach and datadriven decision making to:

- 1) address root causes of violence in our community
- 2) intervene at the first sign of risk and respond effectively when violence does occur
- repair and restore our youth, families, and communities that have been affected by violence
- reduce recidivism rates for focus population


#### OJJDP RECOMMENDED CRITERIA


- have a population of no more than 100,000
- geographically contiguous
- clear geographic boundaries
- a sense of community identity
- most heavily affected by gangrelated violent crime


# FOCUS COMMUNITIES

  Incorporates community input


