


Military & Overseas Voters in Oregon

^{*}The Oregon Constitution, Article II Section IV states that for the purpose of voting, no person shall have lost their Oregon residence due to studies at a Seminary of Learning; while kept at any alms house, or other asylum; at public expense; nor while confined in public prison. While rare, follow-up may be required if there's any indication a voter meets these qualifications. A voter in one of these categories should receive a full Oregon ballot.
